

Setup Instructions

- A. Unpack contents of boxes and lay out for assembly.
- B. Extend legs from stand and secure in outward position by pushing down on cross members (see diagram 1).
- C. Locate mounting blocks and install to underside of each frame as shown in diagram 2 using screw no. 22 (see parts list). Be sure to note hole alignment which is offset toward center of unit).
- D. Align remaining holes in bottom of mounting blocks with holes on stand. Insert washer no. 25 on screw no. 22 and install through bottom of stand and into bottom of mounting blocks.




Frame Holes Toward Center Washer Screw

Operation

- A. Remove center axel and place coil onto bottom rollers. Replace center axel to prevent unraveling (see diagram 3).
- B. Feed coil between bottom rollers and also between the score guide and scoring bed.
- C. Place unit approximately 18 inches from brake (see below).
- D. Pull coil through brake to desired length. Score or cut and separate coil.





Note: As seen to the left, center coil with brake opening and allow material to pass freely through the brake without hitting castings.
